Welcome

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Welcome to Year 4, Deer Class! In this termly newsletter you will find out all about the exciting things we will be learning and any events coming up.

Reading

Whole class reading sessions will take place daily, using a variety of texts. We will focus on developing reading fluency, which children can practise at home by reading frequently. We will also focus on comprehension skills such as inference & retrieval.

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Writing

This term we will studying 'The Barnabus project' by the Fan Brothers. We will be creating our own narratives, learning how to create tense, atmospheric writing through sentence structures and vocabulary choices. We will also be writing our own information texts based on 'creatures' the children will have created after reading the Barnabus Project.



Maths

Our first unit this term is addition and subtraction. We will be learning how to add and subtract numbers up to 1000. We will be looking at abstract along with formal written methods to solve basic calculations and complex problems.



Following this we will be looking at multiplication and division. This will include looking at abstract along with formal written methods.

Science

Our Science topic this term is 'Good vibrations'. In this unit we will learn all about sound. We learn how different sounds are made, how they travel and how sounds change over specific distances. We will also be carrying out experiments looking at how we can use 'air' to make music.

Computing

Our computing topic this term is 'Coding'. The children will create their own programmes, using variables to direct their characters. They will learn how to debug the programme when something is not right. At the end of the term we will be creating our own text-based adventures.



Art & Design/Design & Technology

This term our unit will be 'art' based and more specifically 'sculpture'. We will be looking at how we can use everyday materials to make different sculptures from 'homemade maracas to drums. We also be studying various artists and their sculptures.





Geography/History

On history unit for this term is 'The Romans'. Throughout the unit we will look at the Roman conquest of Great Britain and its lasting impact, as well as broader concepts like 'Invasion', 'Empire' and 'Slavery' and the outcomes they had during Roman times.



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The song we are working on this term is 'Mamma Mia' by ABBA. The children will listen to and appraise this song as well as others. Each lesson we will take part in warm up games, where we move our bodies along to the beat of the music. Having picked up the basics of the 'glockenspiel' in term 1 we will be further developing these skills throughout this term.

PΕ

Our PE unit this term will be gymnastics. We will be working on warming up our bodies effectively, balancing and basic floor routines. As part of this scheme of work we will be using gymnastic equipment.



PSHE

Our PSHE topic this term is 'Celebrating difference'. We will be identifying what it means to be different; looking at themes such as bullying. Throughout the unit we will be looking at what makes us special and how to understand and accept people for who they are.

<u>R</u>E

This term we will be studying Christmas. We will be looking at various celebrations from arc world and who is important at Christmas time.



Enrichment

At the end of this term, we will be a holding a 'Romans themed' fun day. We will have the opportunity to find out more about Roman culture, create a Roman mosaic and try lots of de Enrichment Italian themed food.
