Welcome

Welcome to Autumn 2. Our topic will be based around Traditional stories and modern-day popular stories such as 'The Gruffalo and Stick man'.

Phonics

We are moving forward with our phonics and reading. The children are becoming confident with their letter sounds and blending of words. 

Literacy

Within our literacy sessions, we will be doing lots of writing based around the story and the characters. 

The children will be encouraged to practise and develop their letter formation.

Maths

The children will be encouraged to further develop their number knowledge, recognition and sorting. We will explore weight comparing lighter and heavier, We will also be comparing size big, bigger, small and smaller. 

Communication and language

The children will be encouraged to listen carefully to stories and information shared with them. They will be supported to recap on their learning using any new vocabulary. 

Personal, social and emotional development

We will continue to support the children to make positive relationships with both their peers and the adults in Reception class. The children will continue to develop an understanding of the school rules as well as the class rules. We will continue to encourage independence. 

Physical development

We will be providing activities to further develop the children's fine motor skills which in turn will help with their letter formation. The children will continue to partake in our PE sessions on a Thursday. 

Understanding the world

The children will compare and contrast characters from stories, including figures from the past. They will be encouraged to understand similarities and differences between different religious and cultural communities in this country. 

Helping your child learn at home



Support your child to be independent, putting on and taking off their coats and shoes.

Encourage correct letter formation especially the letters within their names.

Support your children to recognise, sort and count numbers confidently 0-5, 0-10.
